Training will focus on fundamentals of the passing game. For quarterbacks, footwork and throwing will be emphasized with a focus on straight drop-back (three-step and five-step) and sprint-out passing drills. Receivers will be taught fundamentals to improve their route running and catching ability. Campers will have the opportunity to test their skills in a game environment.
